

## **2017 Scott Robertson Memorial Boys Acceptance Criteria (14 & Under age division only)**

The 2017 Scott Robertson Memorial 14 and Under field will consist of 24 players from the categories below, including additions, with spots being filled by applicants from these categories in alphabetical order. Once the field is full (accepting applicants in category A first, B next, and so on), the applicants from lower categories will not gain entry, unless earning a spot through one of the qualifying rounds.

Additions:

1. The entry committee reserves the right to exempt additional players.

2. Winner of Roanoke Valley Junior Golf Association Scott Robertson Memorial Spring Tour (Roanoke Valley) – 14 & under only
3. Top 14 and under qualifier from US Challenge Cup, New England qualifier
4. Top qualifier from the Naples qualifier held at Quail Creek Country Club on April 22, 2017.
5. If there are not enough applicants to fill the field through the entrance criteria, the entrance committee reserves the right to fill the field by other means. This means there could be the addition of a qualifier for the 14 and under boys division, to be held at Roanoke Country Club on Saturday April 29, 2017. Please check the website for updates concerning this possibility.

Example: If 18 players apply from the first 4 categories, all of those applicants will be accepted (this includes additions and any special exemptions granted by the entry committee). If 8 other players have applied from category 5, then 4 of those will be accepted (based on criteria) to reach 24 total. The 4 players in category 5 not chosen will be ranked by the committee as alternates. The remaining applicants will not earn entry. The field size may be reduced if the number of applicants from the 5 categories plus additions is less than 24.

Note: The SRM entry committee reserves the right to review the exemption criteria yearly and make changes as necessary. Decisions of the Entries Committee are final.
